Introduction

This page explains what personal information we gather when you apply via your home institution to be part of the IARU GSP CAM1 programme. The GSP CAM1 programme is part of the International Summer Programmes run by the Institute of Continuing Education. The Institute is part of the University of Cambridge.

Who will process my personal information?

The information published here applies solely to the use of your personal information (also known as 'personal data') by the University of Cambridge's Institute of Continuing Education.

Personal information collected

As you are aware, your home institution sends us your **application form**, which includes personal details. We use these to devise statistics on our overall student profile for CAM1 and our other programmes, such as age range, nationality, degree course. Other personal details are used to help achieve a good balance in supervision groups, between institution and subject area. Personal or institutional email addresses are used before and during the course to ensure we can communicate updates and changes. Permission is sought before sharing emails within the group, with your supervisors, and with Cambridge students intending to attend GSP programmes at our home institution.

If you are in receipt of a Santander grant, you will also have been made aware of the use Santander may make of contact details supplied to them by your home institution.
