

RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM RULES ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Thank you for enrolling your child in Yale Summer Session. We are proud to offer academically rigorous courses and a vibrant residential experience at Yale over the summer. While we admit exceptional high school seniors to study and live alongside Yale College and visiting college students, Yale Summer Session is not a “pre-college” program, and all students are held to the same college-level academic and conduct standards. Since living on a college campus brings a high degree of personal independence and responsibility, we expect parents and guardians, particularly those of high school students, to communicate in advance with their child about behavioral and other expectations.

In order to provide a safe and effective program, we require that all participants abide by the below.

- (1) Participants must follow the instructions of program staff members.
- (2) Participants must not leave the program location without the permission of a program staff member. Participants under the age of 18 must abide by the program’s curfew policy, which will be outlined during orientation.
- (3) Participants must treat other participants and program staff members with respect and must not seek to harass or intimidate other participants, verbally or physically. - (4) Participants must not be in possession of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs. Yale Summer Session’s Summer Colleges are strictly alcohol free, and Yale University is tobacco free.
- (5) Participants must not be in possession of a weapon of any kind.
- (6) Participants must follow the rules and regulations, including those on academic integrity, within the Yale Summer Session *Student Handbook*, which will be available online in the spring.

By signing this document below, I acknowledge that I have read these rules and that I have discussed them with my child. I understand that my child may be removed from the program, at my own expense and without academic credit, if they fail to follow these rules. I will ensure that my child has entered my correct contact information, e.g., telephone number and e-mail address, in their application.
